## 2016 Scholarship Guidelines and General Information

- Five (5) scholarships will be awarded in 2016
- Parent/Legal Guardian and/or student must be a member of Partnership Financial Credit Union.
- Recipients must be graduating seniors from any high school
- Each scholarship will be in the amount of \$2,500 for the first academic year. Funds will be paid directly to the college of the student's choice. These funds will be paid in two (2) \$1,250 installments, providing the student maintains good academic standing. Funds may be used for tuition, books, room or board. If the recipient, for any reason, is placed on academic probation by the college, the remainder of the scholarship may be forfeited.

## Selection Criteria

- Two (2) scholarships will be awarded based on academic achievement (class standing, extracurricular activities and community involvement.)
- Three (3) scholarships will be awarded based on academic achievement (class standing, extracurricular activities and community involvement) **AND** financial need.

  - How do you plan to finance your education?
  - What sources for financial aid are available to you?
    - Family
    - Taking out student loans or private loans
    - Working at a job while attending school
  - What difficulties will you face in paying for your education?
    - Has there been a change in your family or personal situation that is making it difficult for you to pay for college?
  - What would you gain from this scholarship?
